At *Società Dante Alighieri*, Italian language courses for foreigners are divided into 6 levels, according to the Common European Framework of Reference for language skills (Common European Framework of Reference for Languages -CEFR): Basic level (A1 and A2) - Intermediate level (B1 and B2) - Advanced level (C1 and C2)

ORDINARY COURSES (30 hours)
